





8 Goals, 18 Targets, 48 Indicators


















Post-2015 Development Agenda Processes

Key Differences

- Broader agenda in terms of both topics (climate, terrestrial and marine ecosystems) and within the MDG topics (UHC, NCDs, quality education through secondary level)
- Break down silos, explore interlinkages
- Apply to all countries ("universality")
- Zero/Universal goals
- Inclusive ("leave no one behind")





- Social protection systems
- Universal Health Care, affordable, quality drugs & care
- Strengthen network of providers
- Financial resources for R&D and health system strengthening
- Work to reduce barriers to access caused by IP regulations





Equal access to education, including accessible facilities

 Recognize and value unpaid care and domestic work, provide public services





Reliable, modern energy for healthcare

Decent work for all

- Increase R&D funding
- Equal access to infrastructure





End discrimination

• Equal access to public transportation





- Protection of ecosystem services
